## 100 CLUB

Finally, WCS has its own Staging. Now we need to plan to raise additional funding for any modifications that might be needed, as well as ensuring that WCS can provide suitable storage and transport into the future. The Committee has decided, therefore, to establish a 100 CLUB as a way for the Society to raise additional funds with very little outlay and minimum effort on behalf of participants and the Society and some fun and potential gain for WCS Members, Family and Friends

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

- The 100 CLUB is run as a “small society lottery” and is registered with Taunton Deane Borough Council.
- Participants buy numbers (allocated) which are entered into a regular draw eg 100 numbers for a 100 CLUB.
- Participants pay a fixed subscription for their number(s).
- When the draws take place a percentage of the profits are given as prizes with the remainder going to WCS funds.

### WHAT ARE THE PRIZES?

- Each number costs £12 for the year payable in advance.
- The Total Prize Fund equates to half the yearly income.
- There will be 10 monthly draws with three prizes in the ratio of 5:2:1
- The Prize Fund for 10 Months equates to two-thirds of the Total Prize Fund
- In November and May the prize ratio will be 2:1:1
- The Prize Fund for November and May combined equates to one-third of the Total Prize Fund

### EXAMPLE

Assuming 100 Numbers sold the Total Prize Fund = £600

For 10 Months the Prizes will be £25; £10; £5

In November and May the Prizes will be £50; £25; £25

# Wellington Choral Society

## 100 CLUB RULES

- 1 The 'Wellington Choral Society (WCS) 100 Club shall continue as long as deemed viable by the WCS Trustees.
2. The subscription to the 'WCS 100 Club' shall be £12 per year per number, payable in advance by annual standing order on 1st June of each year or by cash/cheque.
- 3 Members may have multiple subscriptions.
- 4 Anybody over the age of 16 can subscribe and participation **is not** restricted to members of the Wellington Choral Society.
5. Members joining later in the year will be charged on a pro-rata basis, to fall in line with the renewal date of 1<sup>st</sup> June each year.
- 6 Member's numbers are eligible for inclusion in the draw for any month so long as each subscription for that month has been paid and cleared before that draw takes place.
- 7 Each member is allocated a permanent number in the monthly draw at £1 per number. This number shall remain that member's number while their subscription is up to date. This number will be allocated by the administrator.
- 8 A member will have been deemed to have left the 100 CLUB if his/her renewal subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 9 If the WCS 100 CLUB is over-subscribed then a waiting list will be instigated.
- 10 There will be one prize draw for each month, on the 3rd Wednesday of the month during WCS terms and at the discretion of the Trustees at all other times.
- 11 A minimum of three Trustees to be present at each draw.
- 12 The Total Prize Fund equates to half the yearly income; the remainder goes to WCS funds.
- 13 There will be 10 monthly draws with three prizes in the ratio of 5:2:1. The Prize Fund for 10 Months equates to two-thirds of the Total Prize Fund.
- 14 In November and May the prize ratio will be 2:1:1. The Prize Fund for November and May combined equates to one-third of the Total Prize Fund.
- 15 The administrator will make all reasonable efforts to pay or post prizes to the winners within 1 week of the draw using the address on the application form.
- 16 In the event that the Prize cheque is not presented for payment within six months of the date of issue, the money will revert as profit for Wellington Choral Society.
- 17 Winners' names will be displayed on the WCS website after each draw.
- 18 A list of all winners will be retained by the Trustees.
- 19 The Wellington Choral Society 100 Club' is registered as a "small society lottery" with Taunton Deane Council – Reg. No: **ML1/0003322**
- 20 In any matter requiring adjudication, the decision of the 'WCS Trustees' shall be final. The Trustees shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their discretion, and will provide reasonable notice to the members where necessary.
